



Palate Notes: A clean and fruity, dry white wine with notes of ripe Bosc pear, white peaches, cantaloupe and hints of guava and elderflowers. This wine has a medium body, crisp acidity and well-balanced tannins.

Serving Suggestions: Perfect as a “patio” wine, to sip by itself, it also pairs extremely well with spicy foods including Mexican, Thai and Indian cuisines.

Optimal Temperature: 38°–42° F

WINEMAKING NOTES

Fermented and aged entirely in Stainless Steel, this wine did not undergo Malo-Lactic (secondary) fermentation; allowing this Grenache Blanc to retain its bright fruit and crisp acidity.
